**College of Architecture Electives may be comprised of any approved undergraduate-level courses offered by the Schools of Architecture, Building Construction, City and Regional Planning, or Industrial Design. Students pursuing the professional track of the undergraduate program must complete 18 semester hours of professional courses in order to complete the Master of Architecture degree within the minimum of 60 semester hours.

***Students pursuing the professional track of the undergraduate program must complete the 10 credit hour senior level studio sequence (ARCH 4011-2) in order to complete the Master of Architecture (M Arch) degree within the minimum of 60 semester hours. A minimum of 10 semester hours in a concentrated cluster of courses is required. Clusters may be developed from courses offered either inside or outside the College of Architecture.
